### SITUATION APPRAISAL -

A Scottish packaging manufacturer had won an order for 5 million bottle tops from a major American whisky brand. Upon delivery of the bottle tops, they did not pass safety inspections as the bottle tops had traces of grease on them which was not food-grade. The products were rejected.

# OUTCOMES '

Other lubricant suppliers suggested products but as many were white in colour, they didn't show up under their UV control lights. Our team attended the site with SKF. They proposed a food-grade grease that was detectable under all their CQ measures.

## **COST SAVING RESULT -**

The rejection of the previous order due to contamination cost them around 50K, so with the change to the SKF foodgrade grease, that risk is erradicated in future.
